### **1. Welcome**

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 PM by Acting Chair, Vivien Gomes-Pollon.

### **3. District School Opening Update**

Presenter: Deputy Superintendent Roberto Bombelli (on behalf of Superintendent Karim Hachlaf)

Mr. Bombelli shared an overview of the 2025–26 school year, including:

- Enrollment trends and staffing updates
- District priorities for the new year
- New initiatives supporting inclusion, learning, and student well-being

#### **5. Tabletop Zone Discussions**

Reps participated in small-group discussions by zone to share priorities and early-year concerns.

Themes identified included:

- Continued concern over the impact of 2024–25 budget cuts (music programs, custodial services, and five-block secondary timetables to accommodate additional students at certain secondary schools)
- The need for stronger PAC–school communication
- Desire for collaborative advocacy across Burnaby zones
- Zone notes will be compiled and summarized for follow-up at a future executive meeting.
- Desire for C&B training for executive committee and members.

Heide presented the 2025–26 DPAC budget, noting:

University Highlands moved, Burnaby Mountain seconded to approve the 2025–26 DPAC budget as presented. Motion carried.

## **8. Draft Policy on Meeting Behaviour**

Presenter: Secretary Brock Stephenson

Brock introduced a draft policy on meeting behaviour, outlining expectations for respectful and productive dialogue during DPAC meetings.

The draft was presented for information only.

The policy will be reviewed by the Executive Committee prior to being brought forward to a future General Meeting for consideration.

## **9. Approval of Previous Minutes**

A representative from Burnaby Mountain Secondary School proposed an amendment to the May 2025 General Meeting minutes.

The motion did not receive a seconder and therefore did not proceed.

University Highlands moved, Glenwood seconded a motion to defer approval of the February, March, and April 2025 General Meeting minutes indefinitely. Motion carried.

Forest Grove moved, University Highlands seconded approving the May 2025 Annual General Meeting minutes to be approved as presented. Motion carried with record vote:
