As you are aware, a tentative agreement between the BC Teacher's Federation (BCT) and the BC Public Service Employers' Association (BCPSEA) was reached early this week. We are hopeful that it will be ratified by provincial teachers and Boards of Education by the end of this week.


If this happens, the 2014/15 school year will officially begin **on Monday, September 22**. It will be a shorter day, as our first day always is, allowing us the opportunity to welcome students and staff back, and to determine enrolment numbers so we can plan classes and prepare for the school year. We invite you to help us continue to create a future where students, parents, principals, teachers, school and district staff, trustees and community partners are proud to be a part of the Burnaby School District.
